The following are preliminary numbers which are subject to corrections until verified and balanced by the main computer program for the Appeal.


This is to inform you that as of **November 28, 2022**, we have received **10** pledges.

Indigenous Pastoral And Lay Leader Ministry Education

Indigenous Pastoral and Lay Leader Ministry Education – Jointly sponsored by the Roman Catholic Diocese of Saskatoon, St. Thomas More College, and Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools, the online Indigenous Pastoral and Lay Leader Ministry Education program is led by teams of Indigenous and non-Indigenous instructors, modelling respectful and reconciling relationships. Course 2: Indigenous-Settler Relationship will be held **Jan. 10, 2023 to March 7, 2023**, offered online from **4:15 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday afternoons**. Registration is now open! Cost is \$200 per course (some funding assistance available.) There is no-prerequisite required to take Course 2. (However, Directed Study is available to take concurrently for those who wish to complete course 1.
